## **LLEWLYN DAVIES YEANG WINS INTERNATIONAL MASTERPLAN COMPETITION**

Llewlyn Davies Yeang (LDY), the UK-based sister company of T.R. Hamzah & Yeang, were the recent winners of the International Masterplan Competition for the Istanbul waterfront site. Organised by the Istanbul Municipality, the competition drew various entries from across the globe. The competition's objective was for a masterplan that would be a major transportation route that would link the east and west waterfronts of Istanbul to the rest of Turkey. LDY's winning design consists of a 2-kilometre long continuous ecological corridor (with eco bridges), a new urban park for the Istanbul along the waterfront, as well as a planning armature for linking the existing and various land uses for the locality. Aside for enhancing the locality's biodiversity, the designed ecological corridor promises to make the existing devastated ecosystem whole again.
