

# PAM/ JOHNSON SUISSE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 In 2004 Johnson Suisse, the popular sanitary ware manufacturer has agreed to sponsor students of architecture in Malaysia, in collaboration with PAM. The Award is a lump sum financial award to students studying in a PAM/LAM accredited degree course.
- 1.2 The sponsor has committed to make available 2 Awards annually, to deserving student until his/her graduation.

## 2.0 TITLE OF AWARD

- 2.1 The award shall be known as **“PAM-Johnson Suisse Scholarship Award”**.

## 3.0 VALUE OF AWARD

- 3.1 The value of the annual stipend per student for this award is a lump sum of **RM7,500.00** (Ringgit Malaysia: Seven thousand five hundred only) per academic year.

## 4.0 AWARD JURY

- 4.1 The Award jury shall consists of 3 eminent persons as follows;
  - 4.1.1.1 PAM Senior Advisor – to be elected by PAM council at each council year. He shall be a past PAM chairman.
  - 4.1.1.2 Johnson Suisse current Managing Director,
  - 4.1.1.3 PAM Education Committee Chairman for council year.
- 4.1.2 The decisions made by Award jury are final and no further correspondence is entertained.

## 5.0 AWARD RULES & CONDITIONS

- 5.1 All Nominations shall be addressed to PAM Secretariat. PAM education committee and its chairman will make recommendations for approval and endorsement by Award jury.
- 5.2 Only short listed candidates will be notified and may be called for an interview.
- 5.3 The applicant shall not be bonded with or holding any other scholarship or receiving financial assistance from any other organization.
- 5.4 The Award is applicable to all students with academic merit in Malaysian schools of architecture leading to a professional

degree in Architecture. The university shall be running a LAM/PAM accredited course in architecture.

- 5.5 To be eligible for the Award applicants must be below 25 years of age as of closing date for application. Closing date for application is **28<sup>th</sup> August 2010**.
- 5.6 Applications can be made in writing to PAM Secretariat entitled '**PAM-Johnson Suisse Award**'. All applications must be endorsed by Head of department, School of Architecture.
- 5.7 The academic performance of the recipient student will be monitored by PAM education committee and must exceed 3.00 CGPA in year 1 and shall not be lower than 2.7 CGPA in year 2. Recipient shall submit his/her transcript to PAM at the end of first year of the degree course before recommendation and disbursement for year 2 can be made.
- 5.8 Recommendation and selection of recipient shall be based on the following category (in terms of priority);  
( Supporting evidence and verified documents shall be submitted together with the application)
  - 5.8.1 Excellent academic records,
  - 5.8.2 Family economic background,
  - 5.8.3 Recommendations by Heads of school, and
  - 5.8.4 Referral and/or other supporting documents.
