**PROPOSAL TO AMEND THE PAM BYELAWS**

- **TO REDUCE THE PERIOD TO 30 DAYS INSTEAD OF 60 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF THE GENERAL MEETING FOR COUNCIL TO DECIDE WHETHER TO HOLD THE GENERAL MEETING BY VIRTUAL PARTICIPATION OR IN-PERSON.**

We refer to the above notification to all members ref. no. PAM/SA/01/06/22-4 dated 5<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

Pursuant to Clause 20.2(b) of the PAM Constitution, this serves to notify all members that the proposed Byelaws have become effective at the expiry of 30 days' notice, i.e., 4<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

We wish to inform members that as of 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2022, the Honorary Secretary **did not receive** any notice from 50 Corporate Members for an Extraordinary General Meeting to be convened for the purpose of considering, confirming or revoking the proposed Byelaws.

Pursuant to Clause 20.2(c), if no such notice is received by the Honorary Secretary, the Byelaws shall become binding on all members at the expiry of the above-mentioned thirty days.
