

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A. INTRODUCTION

The main goal of the international competition, organized by ARCHIDEX and Pertubuhan Akitek Malaysia (PAM) is to solicit new innovative architectural and urbanistic ideas dealing with current issues and challenges. The competition expects to generate thoughtful and provocative ideas that truly benefit mankind. A design challenge for the competition is to define architecture by proposing a design solution ranging from urban to architectural scale. Beyond a simple design competition, ARCHITALENT will continue to encourage creation, audacity and the capacity to imagine visions in realizing the world of the built environment.

B. THEME

'THE NEXUS'

ARCHITALENT 2024 invites emerging future architects to delve into the evolving landscape of THE NEXUS, building upon the groundwork laid by The Realm (2023). The competition brief challenges participants to navigate the intricate interplay between physical and virtual spaces, urging them to envision environments that seamlessly harmonize with both realms. Proposals must not only address the practical needs of the physical built environment but also explore the immersive experiences facilitated by digital technologies.

In this transition from The Realm to THE NEXUS (2024), future architects find themselves at the nexus of physical and virtual realities. THE NEXUS represents a paradigm shift, where architecture transcends traditional boundaries to seamlessly integrate with virtual environments, creating immersive and hyperrealistic experiences - at the verge of the metaverse. Structures become interconnected nodes within a vast network of digital interactions, reshaping how we perceive and engage with our surroundings.

As participants immerse themselves in THE NEXUS, they must embrace the concept of connectivity in its broadest sense. Designing for this hybrid environment demands a holistic approach that acknowledges the interconnectedness of physical structures, digital technologies, and human experiences.



Future architects must deeply understand how these elements converge to shape the built environment and influence human interaction within spaces.

THE NEXUS embodies more than a mere convergence of physical and virtual realms; it represents the interconnectedness of ideas, technologies, and experiences. As future architects navigate this hybrid landscape, they must forge connections that transcend traditional boundaries, fostering meaningful interactions between people and their environments.

ARCHITALENT 2024 serves as a platform for future architects to explore the transformative potential of THE NEXUS. It encourages participants to challenge conventional notions of space, experience, and interaction, envisioning a future where architecture seamlessly integrates with the digital landscape to enhance the quality of life for all inhabitants.

C. ELIGIBILITY

- i. Open to full-time students from ARCASIA member institutes including Malaysia which pursuing architecture programs https://arcasia.org/country-zone/.
- ii. Participation is open to INDIVIDUALS only.
- iii. The official language of the competition is ENGLISH.
- iv. Participants are not allowed to submit two or more projects/designs and work has not been submitted to any other competition prior to ARCHITALENT only.
- v. No participation fee and FREE ADMISSION to participate in this competition.
- vi. CERTIFICATES of participation, achievements and appreciation will be given to participants and lecturers after the event.

D. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENT

PHASE 1 (Call For Entry)

All submissions are required and limited to:

- Maximum of two (2) AO-sized (portrait) Posters in High-Resolution Portable Document (PDF) file format with a minimum 300dpi resolution and the file must not exceed 10MB.
- One (1) page A4 in High-Resolution Portable Document (PDF) file format of Project Description (Font type: Arial, Size: 11)

The name of the student, school, or any identification MUST NOT appear on the board or any presentation material. Failure to follow the above qualifications will cause your submission.

PHASE 2 (10 Finalists)

10 shortlisted finalists (7 Malaysia & 3 International) will be announced and notified via email on 10 June 2024. Please make sure your email and phone number are written correctly and clearly to avoid confusion and missing the presentation.

Finalists are required to present their submission in front of the Panel of Judges on 6 July 2024, 10.00 AM – 1.00 PM (Malaysia Time) at the PAM Pavilion, Hall 8, Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre (KLCC) and each finalist will be given 5 minutes of presentation time only.

Supporters, friends, lecturers and members of the public are strongly encouraged to attend to give support and entry is free.

* Innovative Design Approach 20%
* Sustainability 20%
* Presentation 40%
