Being an active researcher, many of her works have been published as academic referral publications. She has been the chairperson for the International Conference on the Universal Design in the Built Environment (ICUDBE), organizing Universal Design Product Competition (UDPC) and chairing a one-day Symposium on Trends in Universal Design (STUD). She has presented papers locally and abroad as speaker and invited keynote speaker. She also have been involve in Access Audit for various building typologies for more than 500 buildings since 2008 in Malaysia.
