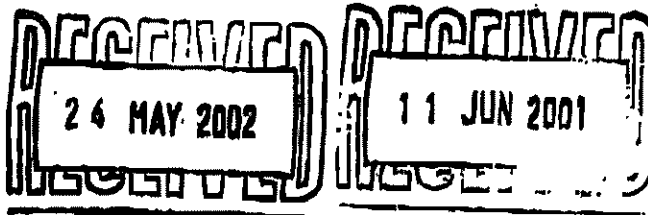

## CIDB GREEN CARD PROGRAM

With reference to your letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> May 2001, please be informed that it is the government wish that all personnel who works at the site should attend a one-day safety induction course.

2) The CIDB Green Card Program is an amalgamation of the registration of construction personnel and the safety induction course. The CIDB Green Card is a prove that one has attended the safety induction course.

3) CIDB is targeting the Green Card Program to :-

- i) All personnel who works full time at the site.
- ii) All personnel who work a total of 8 hours in a week.

4) Those personnel who falls outside the said category will be allowed to follow the site safety rules and regulation especially pertaining to usage of personal protective equipment.

5) Accidents can happen to anyone regardless whether the personnel is a manual worker, owner, skill worker, project manager or consultants. Therefore it is advisable that all personnel attend the one-day safety induction course stipulated by the government.
