Architects do their bit for Typhoon Haiyan victims

THE Malaysian Institute of Architects (PAM) and The Malaysian Red Crescent Society (MRCS) have launched a campaign called "Architects Malaysia for Haiyan Philippines" to help the victims of Typhoon Haiyan which destroyed parts of the Philippines earlier this month.

Every ringgit raised from this month-long campaign will be remitted to the MRCS, which will

subsequently channel the funds to the Philippines' Red Cross without any administration charges.

The campaign ends on Dec 17.

Donations through cheques must be made payable to Pertubuhan Akitik Malaysia and 100% of the proceeds will go to victims of Typhoon Haiyan in Philippines.
